## CLAY WORK

### POTTERY – Casual Classes

These classes are perfect for beginners and those wishing to refresh their skills. Learn how to make, decorate and glaze pots, both wheel-thrown and hand-built, eg pinch pots, press-moulded pots, slab-built and coil pots.

**Cost of Class:** \$20 per class. **Cost of Clay:** \$5.00 per kg, includes firing fees and basic glazes. Also includes workshop notes on the variety of making, decorating and glazing techniques covered in the classes.

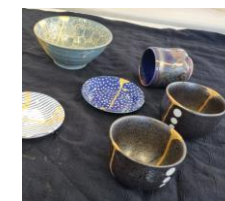

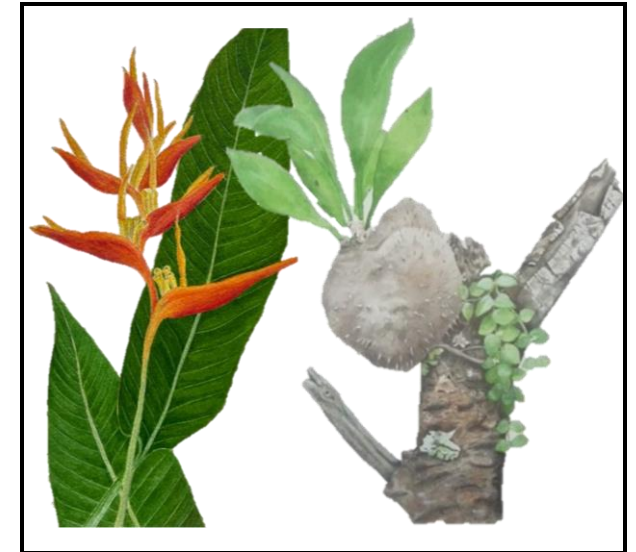
