## CLAY WORK

**POTTERY – Casual Classes**

**Mondays 9.30am – 12.30pm**

**Tutors: Wendy Wajer, Caroline Walker-Grime & Ellen Terrell**  
Perfect for beginners and those wishing to refresh their skills. Beginners will commence with a series of weekly projects. Learn how to make, decorate and glaze pots, both wheel-thrown and hand-built eg pinch pots, press-moulded pots, slab-built & coil pots

**Cost of Class: \$20 per class – no need to book**

**Cost of Clay: \$5.50 per kg**, includes firing fees and basic glazes, plus workshop notes on techniques covered in the classes.

**WORKING with CLAY – Peer Groups**

For those with some experience in working with clay. (*Beginners need to attend casual classes first, refer above.*)

Equipment for both hand-building and wheel throwing is provided. Clay and some tools are available for purchase.
