POTTERY – Options for Beginners and Experienced Potters!

FOUNDATIONS IN POTTERY - Two 5 x week Courses (repeated)

Course 1: Saturdays 12 July to 9 Aug, 9.30am-12.30pm

Course 2: Saturdays 13 Sept to 11 Oct, 9.30am-12.30pm

Tutor: Bianca Velder

Participants will be equipped with essential clay knowledge and hand-building skills to then continue their pottery journey. Learn a new technique each week and complete a project to take home.

Cost: \$250 non-members (\$230 members' discount) each course, includes 1 x bag clay, basic pottery tool kit & certificate on completion. **(Payment codes: FIP1 & FIP2)**

GLAZING YOUR POTTERY UFO's (UnFinished Objects)

Learn the wonderful art of pottery wheel-throwing with Caroline's expert guidance. Participants must be experienced in working with clay. Saturday's session will be making pots, then on Sunday you will learn how to turn and finish those pots.
