MIXED MEDIA

CYANOTYPE WORKSHOP Tutor: Mollie Bosworth

Sunday 23 August, 10am – 4pm

Cyanotype is a Victorian photographic process that transforms sunlight, chemistry and everyday objects into vivid Prussian-blue prints. Participants will explore and learn the classic formula, create photograms from found objects and turn drawings into striking cyanotype images. Suitable for beginners.

LINO PRINTMAKING

Sat 14 November 10am – 4pm Tutor: Caroline Walker-Grime

Explore lino printing - a relief printing technique which involves cutting a design into a block of lino with sharp tools, rolling ink onto the raised area and applying paper with pressure to reveal the print. This workshop will focus on black and white prints exploring the range of marks lino cutting tools can produce.
